

Study and Research in Germany – Admission Requirements

Undergraduate Studies

High school diploma and 2 years undergraduate studies in the Philippines



assessment test including a language exam*

(usually after a 2 semester-long preparatory course in Germany)



Admission to Bachelor studies

or

3 years undergraduate studies at a recognized university in the Philippines



German language test*



Admission to Bachelor studies

or

Bachelor's Degree after 4 years of Undergraduate Studies (if pursued studies in Germany are related to previous studies in the Philippines, courses taken in the 4th year will be recognized in Germany)

Bachelor's degree from a recognized university in the Philippines and a Master's degree (credit period of 3 years)**

Admission to Doctorate Studies

*There are more than 700 international degree courses taught in English.

**Due to the difference between German and Philippine education systems, a specified number of years of education must first be pursued in the Philippines, before applying for its German counterpart of the same level. Thus, the subjects taken in the 4th year of the undergraduate studies and the courses taken for 2 years in the master's degree program are needed to make up for the 3 year difference between the systems of education.

Note:

If you have not yet obtained a PhD in the Philippines, it is possible to apply for the Doctorate Program with only a Master's Degree if you are able to find a German professor who will agree to be your supervisor.
